

CUSTOMFLEX[®] ARTIFICIALIRIS

80 y.o. male with glare, photophobia, and blurred vision one year after cataract surgery complicated by iris loss. His exam was notable for VA 20/25-2, posterior synechiae to the lens haptic, posterior capsule opacity and endothelial cell density = 780 cells/mm².

He underwent a limited pars plana vitrectomy, posterior capsulectomy, lysis of synechiae and placement of a CUSTOMFLEX[®] ARTIFICIALIRIS. Postop photo is 4 wks postop; marked reduction in glare, improved vision subjectively. VA stable at 20/25-2, cornea clear.
