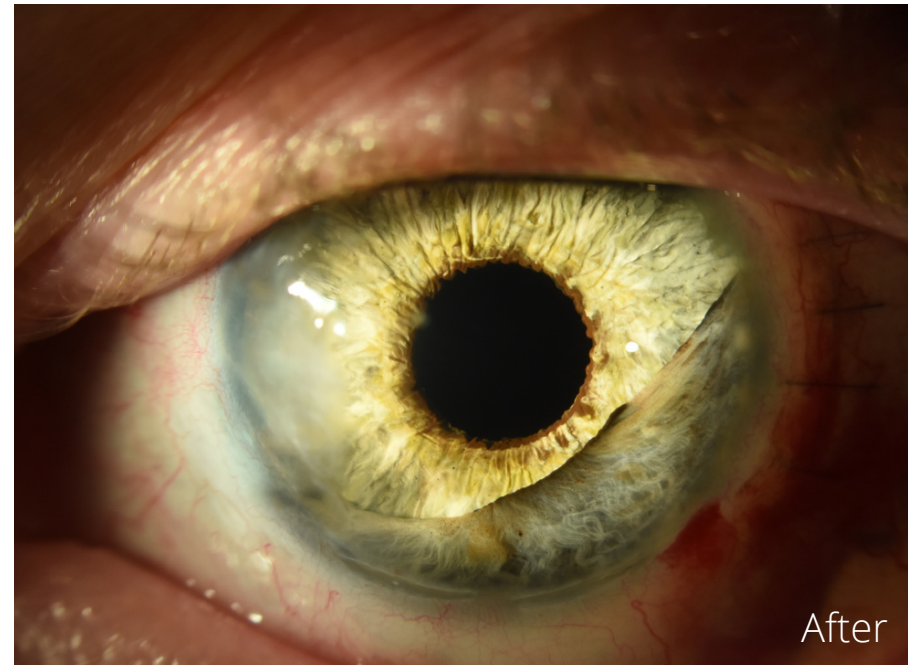
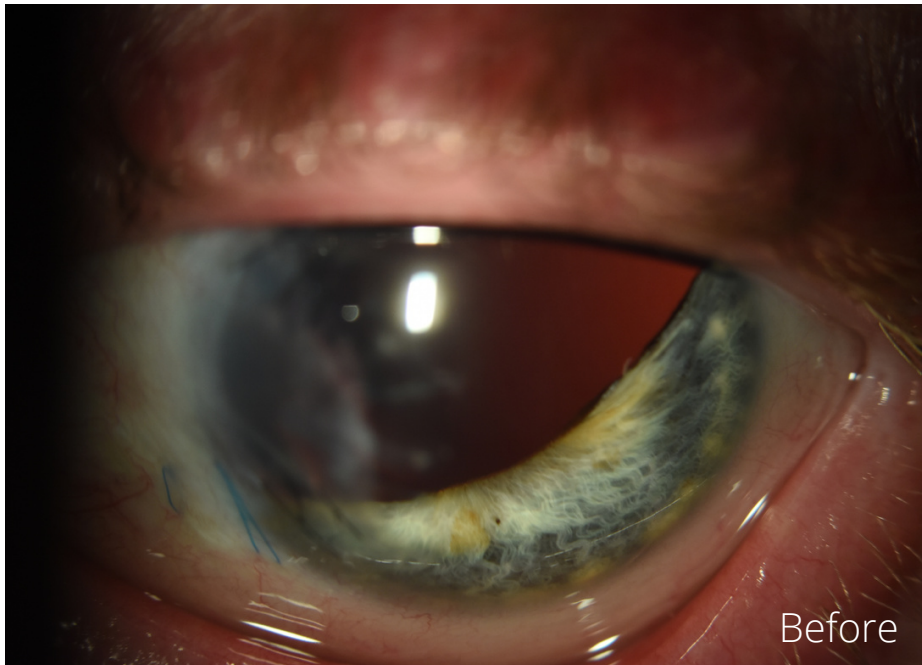

Patient is a 35-year-old active Marine Corps officer who “pretty much had no vision” after a metal flagpole caused an open globe injury to his left eye in July 2020. With the resulting aphakia and loss of 90% of his iris, he suffered severe light sensitivity, headaches, and loss of equilibrium. He feared that his injury would end his military career.
