76 y.o. female with Urrets-Zavalía syndrome after IOP spike with cataract surgery. Suture pupilloplasty in 2002 helped the photophobia; but afterwards, her pupil gradually enlarged to 5-6 mm and her symptoms worsened. In March 2018, a CUSTOMFLEX[®] ARTIFICIAL IRIS was placed in the sulcus with marked improvement in symptoms. Patient is now 20/20 with minimal refractive error.
