
## CUSTOMFLEX® ARTIFICIALIRIS: Photo of the Month





A 65-year-old woman presented with a chief complaint of significant photophobia and blurry vision in her right eye. Her ocular history included a visually significant cataract and iritis in the right eye, creating significant transillumination defects (See "Before" Image). Her best corrected vision was 20/60-2.

Following cataract extraction, placement of CUSTOMFLEX® ARTIFICIALIRIS (See "After" Image), and a monofocal IOL, her best corrected vision is 20/20; and, she no longer suffers from the debilitating photophobia she experienced preoperatively.
