CUSTOMFLEX® ARTIFICIALIRIS

Patient referred with most of his iris missing from surgical trauma. A large calcified Soemmering's ring is dislocated into the visual axis, which is also causing chronic iritis/CME; and, the old PMMA IOL is loose and dislocated. We removed the IOL and large S ring, sutured a CZ70BD IOL, a With-Fiber CUSTOM*FLEX*® ARTIFICIAL*IRIS* using GORE-TEX®; combined with PPV and removal of remaining chips and endolaser to retina tear discovered during surgery.

At 1 month post op, patient's vision had improved to 20/40 uncorrected from CF and is extremely pleased with the functional and cosmetic gains. He is very grateful for this technology and feels that it was well worth the wait!
