Patient's History:

- 67 y/o female 1 year after traumatic cataract surgery by outside MD with 6 clock hours of iris damage.
- Referred to retina MD, underwent PPV/Yamane fixated IOL.
- 6 months after PPV/Yamane fixated IOL, she developed bullous keratopathy with diffuse corneal edema, 20/400 vision, and significant photophobia and glare.



<u>Implantation/Post-Op Results:</u>

- Underwent combined DSAEK and CUSTOM*FLEX*® ARTIFICIAL*IRIS* implantation (with fiber) suture fixated in the sulcus.
- 1 month after surgery, BCVA 20/40, significant improvement in glare, and a happy patient.
