

CUSTOMFLEX® ARTIFICIALIRIS: Photo of the Month

42 y.o. male who suffered from an open globe injury with traumatic total aniridia and cataract. Vision pre-op was HM with unbearable photosensitivity; necessitating eye patch to be worn at all times. Dr. Asghari performed PK, complex cataract surgery, IOL implantation, anterior vitrectomy, and artificial iris implantation.

"Uncorrected vision 2 weeks post-op was 20/80 and was recently refracted after management of the graft sutures to a BCVA of 20/25. He is very happy with his vision and cosmesis; has no light sensitivity; and, does not have to wear pirate patch anymore." -Dr. Asghari
